Suppose now that the object which is the source of light be brought nearer so that it is at A in Fig. 40, which is a duplicate of Fig. 39. Then the same thing will happen again. The rays of light will diverge, this being the effect of minus lenses, and the virtual image will be found still nearer to the lens at F. It is therefore evident that A and the distant object of Fig. 39 were not conjugate and that with minus lenses no matter how far or near the object may be the image is always on the same side of the lens and nearer to it, and that this image is always a virtual one.
